What does the money benefit?

50% of the profits go to Joey's Little Angels and 50% of the profits go to STLDA Scholarship Program. In the past three years, the 24-Hour soccer marathon has directly supported 5 families in the St. Louis community whose children were faced with medical challenges. In addition, toys from the JLA annual toy drive have been sent to both local pediatric hospitals.

What is the mission of Joey's Little Angels?

JLA is organized exclusively for charitable purposes and for making distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. JLA's mission is to provide emotional and financial support to families with a child undergoing medical treatment.



Why are we doing this?

To have players and families donate their time and energy by helping raise money to support this cause. *All donations are tax-deductible.*

How does the 24-Hour Soccer Marathon work?

Each STLDA team will contribute about 1.5 hours of playing time during the event. Each age group will be assigned a time together to play a game of pick-up soccer with each other. Coaches should work together to create a fun pick-up soccer game. Younger-age teams will **not** be scheduled in the middle of the night. All high school aged players will follow MSHSAA rules.

How does the fundraiser work?

Each player will solicit contributions based on the club playing 24 hours. Although the premise is to receive donations based on the 24-hour period, we welcome any donation.

Tell me about the white envelopes.

Each player received a white envelope that is used to collect and hold all checks/cash. If you lose your white envelope, any envelope from home will work. Make sure to write your Player Name, Team Name, and exact amount of money within the SEALED envelope.

What do I do with the white envelope?

The Coach or Manager will collect ALL players' envelopes and bundle them together to be turned in on the day of the event. If you forget your envelope at your specific event time, please drop it off in the "STLDA" slot no later than April 10 for your donation to count towards this year's event.
